### Proposed Junction Alterations and Enhanced Restrictions

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to advise you Staffordshire County Council is proposing to carry out junction improvements and enhance signage and parking restrictions. Amendments to the highway are proposed on The Avenue, Liverpool Road, Heathcote Street, King Street and Market Street.

This letter represents the commencement of the informal public consultation phase which will conclude on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

I have enclosed a copy of the official consultation drawing ref: **CDT6621-R01-01\_C0-Consultation** which illustrate the proposals in plan.

#### The Avenue with Liverpool Road:

- **Introduce new left and right turning lanes at the signalised junction;**
- **Resite Bus Stop away from the junction, introducing new parking prohibition of No Waiting at Any Time;**
- **Install new high visibility guardrail and enhance No Loading at Any Time roadmarkings;**
- **Amend traffic signal phasing and remove signals from Heathcote Street;**
- **Install new One Way signage;**

#### Heathcote Street with King Street:

- **Install new zebra crossing and signage;**
- **Construct new kerbline and footway at zebra crossing location;**
- **Install new No Left Turn and No Right Turn signage;**
- **Install new No-Entry signage;**
- **Resite telephone box away from proposed zebra crossing;**

Amendments to these junctions aim to reduce an ongoing concern with air pollution.

This letter does not form part of any formal traffic regulation order consultation process and at this stage we only wish to receive comments you may have regarding the proposal which could then be fed back into the design of the traffic order. There will be an opportunity for formal objections to be submitted during the public advertisement phase of the traffic order process, this is when copies of the order will be placed in the local press, at a local community facility, such as a library or village hall, and on site via street notices in the area where the amendment is proposed.
