Re ADC/Kidsgrove Town Centre Traffic Management/SCC/CDT6621-01 Proposed Junction Alterations and Enhanced Restrictions

Kidsgrove Town Council considered this at a meeting on the 27th February 2020 and resolved to agree the following comments:

1. It appears from the plans that turning right into Heathcote Street from Liverpool Road will still be permitted. The Town Council would like to inform that these right turning cars are a significant cause of hold-ups and prevention of free moving traffic along Liverpool Road coming from the Stoke direction towards Cheshire.
2. The Town Council sympathises with residents who will find themselves with the moved bus shelter in front of their home on The Avenue and would like to ask if there are any alternatives. Could the bus-stop be placed in front of the sub-station?
3. The Town Council ask what effect the proposed Lidl will have on the traffic and whether this has been accounted for in the plans.
4. The Town Council would like to ask if there has been any communication with the recently formed Town Board and their plans for Kidsgrove?
5. The junction of Gloucester Road with Liverpool Road is in need of resurfacing and should be included in any proposed work.

The Town Council thank Staffordshire County Council for providing the opportunity for comment on these plans and request that we may be kept updated on any future changes.
