EC/25-26/01/05 Budget To Date

Members discussed the events budget. Clerk advised that next year the office was hoping to get some sponsors towards the Christmas Lights so that this can be put towards some additional lighting. The Switch On was discussed along the pantomime. D Day Events was discussed and whether this line was required as it was a special event as we had the other budget line Events- Other. Both the Lantern Parade and Remembrance Sunday was discussed and the budget required for both events. The Clerk advised that the Christmas Market budget was just in case anything was required for the market, for example printing, small prizes.

Remembrance Parade

The Clerk advised that the road application had been applied for and awaiting confirmation, a meeting was held with the road closure company, and it was agreed due to the issues that occurred during last year that a 3rd operative would be in place.

Christmas 2025

Members discussed the Lantern Parade; a member of Go Kidsgrove advised that the work shops were all in hand and on the following dates: Saturday 15th and 22nd of November with the Lantern Parade on 29th November. The parade route was discussed, and the logistics of the current route due to the size of the parade now, which had significantly grown over the years and a new route was proposed. This would entail the band and the parade to continue without the need to stop at the town hall and struggle to turn round and restart. The new route will start from St Thomas on The Avenue come to the lights and turn avenue and then at the lights turn up Heathcote Street onto King Street. It will miss out Liverpool Road and the Town Hall, Carols would now be performed at the Tree on King Street along with the Choir and Brass Band. Small fairground rides will be located in the semi circle in front of the shop on King Street. It is hoped to have a character attend like last year. A potential of gazebos was proposed for the brass band and the choir subject to weather conditions, a potential trailer with sides was discussed and whether that would be an option if the weather forecast is against us?

The Mayors Charity Santa run update was that the Mayor could not attend this year and a call out to all Cllrs to be done. The Clerk advised the date was 11th December however she would need to confirm this.

Members were advised that a real tree was going in King Street this year, and that due to the issues of the tree opposite the Town Hall that this was now not practical to be used due to the stye of tree it is and that every year the council is having to pay for repairs to the tree lights and every year they keep breaking. The Clerk advised that this would be looked at for next year, however with the new hall lights and that soe additional new lights were to be sourced for the outside of the Town Hall.
